#### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

#### UNDER THE

### GENERAL NOT FOR PROFIT CORPORATION ACT

#### KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

We, the undersigned, JOHN PAUL HELEINE, Box 188C, Forestell Missouri, DONALD GENE QUALLS, R. R. 2, Wentzville, Missouri, RICHARD PHILLIPS, 1440 Kathleen, Wentzville, Missouri, DEWEY COLLINS, R. R. 1, St. Peters, Missouri, and A. J. SAMONS, R. R. 1, O'Fallon Missouri, being natural persons of the age of twenty-one years or more and citizens of the United States, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the "General Not For Profit Corporation Act" of the State of Missouri, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

#### ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is Wentzville Christian Church.

#### ARTICLE II

The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.

#### ARTICLE III

#### ARTICLE IV

The first Board of Directors shall be five (5) in number, their names and addresses being as follows: JOHN PAUL HELEINE, Box 188C, Forestell, Missouri; DONALD GENE QUALLS, R. R. 2, Wentzville, Missouri; RICHARD PHILLIPS, 1440 Kathleen, Wentzville, Missouri; DEWEY COLLINS, R. R. 1, St. Peters, Missouri; and A. J. SAMONS, R. R. 1, O'Fallon, Missouri.

#### ARTICLE V

This corporation is formed for the purpose of carrying on religious activities and for the purpose of holding title to real estate for the church edifices and parsonages, cemeteries, and such other real estate as may be necessary for the use and benefit of the congregation of the Wentzville Christian Church.

#### ARTICLE VI

This corporation shall not be used for either business or political purposes, or for pecuniary gain or profit of its members

#### ARTICLE VII

The corporation shall be an autonomous congregation not subject to control by any other corporation, congregation or ecclesiastical body. The control, direction and management of the affairs and property of this corporation shall be governed by a Board of Directors of five (5) members. Its officers shall consist of a President, lst Vice President, 2nd Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer and such other officers as may be provided for by the By-Laws from time to time.

#### ARTICLE VIII

The Board of Directors shall adopt By-Laws, Rules and Regulations for the government of the corporation, which may be changed from time to time subject to the approval of a majority of the members of the corporation attending a meeting duly called for that purpose.

#### ARTICLE IX

In the event of dissolution of this corporation, or if for any reason the purposes of this corporation should become impossible of performance, all assets remaining after all liabilities and obligations of the corporation have been paid, satisfied and discharged, or adequate provision made therefor, shall be distributed to one or more organizations organized and operated for similar exempt purposes or for religious, charitable, scientific, literary or educational purposes or for the prevention of cruelty to children or animals and which have exemption from Federal income tax under section 501(c) (3) of the 1954 Internal Revenue Code or such section as it may be amended or a corresponding provision of a prior law, or to the Federal, State, or local government, for a public purpose.

#### ARTICLE X

No one shall be denied membership solely for reasons of race or color.
