### Mission Trip Team Covenant

#### As a member of this team, I agree to:

- 1. Remember that I am representing Jesus Christ as well as WCC. I will model Jesus in my behavior and attitude.
- 2. Remember that I am a guest working at the invitation of my hosts. (Remember the missionary's prayer, "Where You lead me I will follow; what they feed me I will swallow.")
- Remember that we have come to learn, as well as to teach. Resist the temptation to inform our hosts about 'how we do things.' Be open to learning about other people's methods and ideas.
- Respect the host's view of Christianity recognizing that Christianity has many faces
  throughout the world and that the purpose of this trip is to experience faith lived out in a
  new setting.
- 5. Develop and maintain a servant attitude toward all locals, leaders, and other teammates.
- 6. Respect my team leader(s) and his or her decisions.
- 7. Refrain from gossip.
- 8. Refrain from complaining. Travel can present numerous unexpected and undesired circumstances, but the rewards of conquering such circumstances are innumerable. Instead of whining and complaining, be creative and supportive.
- 9. Watch facial expressions. (We communicate a lot through our faces disapproval, judgment, and pleasure. Remember to communicate the right thing at the right time. If someone says, "Do you like the food?" and your facial expression looks like you just swallowed a tarantula, nothing you say will come through.) Your facial expression will speak for you.
- 10. Attend all team meetings before the trip as well as any follow-up meetings.
- 11. Remember not to be exclusive in my relationships. (If a boyfriend/girlfriend is on the team, make every effort to interact with all the members of the team. If attracted to a teammate, do not attempt to pursue a relationship until after we return home.)
- 12. Refrain from any activity that could be construed as romantic interest in a local or teammate
- 13. Abstain from consumption of alcoholic beverages or the use of tobacco while on this trip.
- 14. Abide by the fundraising procedures endorsed by WCC and personally thank all financial donors that contribute to my trip.
- 15. Participate in fundraisers. Not only to help yourself, but your team as well. (If you are not able to attend a fundraiser you will be expected to send someone in your place.)
- 16. Remember that I can be sent home if I do not adhere to this Covenant or if my Team Leader believes it is in my best interest or that of the team.
