- Deliver a message at least once a month during Sunday or Wednesday programming
- Support and assist in leading the Student Leadership Group (SLG)
- Build authentic relationships with students and adult volunteers

2. Coordinate Events & Special Programs

Help organize and execute events that enhance spiritual formation and community.

- Participate in mission trips, retreats, camps, CIY conferences, and outreach projects
- Assist with scheduling, communication, and volunteer coordination for these events



3. Support Volunteer Engagement & Teamwork

Partner with adult leaders to recruit, train, and encourage volunteers who serve alongside the ministry.

- Provide ongoing support and communication with volunteers
- Help onboard new leaders and maintain a healthy volunteer team
