This ministry is designed to meet the academic, mental, physical, spiritual, social and emotional needs of each child. We are committed to preparing children for the BIG world they will enter with fun, engaging, hands on curriculum. Our mission is to ignite a passion for Jesus, the Bible, the Church and Others and lead them in the knowledge of our three basic truths – God made them, God loves them and Jesus wants to be their friend forever!

WCP's classroom hours are Monday – Friday from 8:30 to 2:30. We offer before and after care at an additional cost. Before care opens at 7:00 a.m. and after care closes at 5:00 p.m.

We accept children ages 3 to 5 (pre-Kindergarten). Children must be 3 years of age before August 1st of the current school year to enroll at the preschool.

All enrolled must be 100% toilet trained.

Although we have a great staff to student ratio, we are not equipped for a 1:1 ratio.

We are open and follow the Wentzville School District's event calendar year (August through May) with the exception of the first and last day of school.

Our programs:

Preschoolers (ages 3 and 4) we offer a 2 (Tuesday/Thursday), 3 (Monday/Wednesday/Friday) and 5 day (Monday through Friday) program.

Kindergarten Readiness (PreK) we offer a 3 day (Tuesday/Wednesday/Thursday) and 5 day (Monday through Friday) program.

Curriculum:

Preschoolers (3 and 4 year old's) learn through discovery, exploration and play. Their curriculum is theme-based using different activities as they explore literacy, math, science, music, social skills and more. We incorporate a passion for Jesus, the Bible, the church and others into our curriculum throughout each day. They are introduced to a new letter and number each week, shapes and colors will be focused on each month. Fine motor skills are strengthened with coloring, name writing, painting, cutting, finger plays, etc... By the end of the school year, our goal is that your preschooler will:

- Know that God made them, God loves them and Jesus wants to be their friend forever

- Gained age-appropriate social skills
- Introduce and be successful in the use of scissors, crayons, glue, pencil etc...
- Have a love for school and a passion for learning
- Gained a strong foundation for literacy which leads to reading success
- To introduce and for them to identify shapes, colors, letters and numbers

We challenge the preschoolers in this program to begin to be more independent as the year goes on to prepare them for the Kindergarten Readiness program.

Kindergarten Readiness (PreK) is an adventure in discovery, exploration and a launch into academics. With the advancement to our Kindergarten Readiness program, comes more structure. Their curriculum is also theme-based using different activities as they explore literacy, math, science, music, social skills and more. We incorporate a passion for Jesus, the Bible, the church and others into our curriculum each day. They are reinforced with a new letter and number each week, shapes and colors will be focused on each month. Fine motor skills are strengthened with coloring, name writing, painting, cutting, finger plays, etc... By the end of the school year, our goal is that your Pre-K child will:

- Know that God made them, God loves them and Jesus wants to be their friend forever
- Gained age-appropriate social skills
- Successfully used scissors, crayons, glue, pencil etc...
- Have a firm understanding of his/her writing capability (writing their name, alphabet letters, numbers etc...)
- Have a love for school and a passion for learning
- Gained a strong foundation for literacy which leads to reading success
- Identify shapes, colors, numbers and letters.

The Kindergarten Readiness is more structured to prepare them for Kindergarten. We encourage the “Kindergarten Way” in all we do with this age, leading them even more in developing their independence.

Learning through play:

Why do we play so much in the classrooms at Wentzville Christian Preschool? **Because play IS the work of a child!** Research has shown that play is the most effective way to teach preschoolers.

Here’s some of the things we are learning through play:

- **Social skills** like sharing and self-control
- **Fine motor skills** to prepare for holding writing tools
- **Gross motor skills** like coordination and balance
- **Creative expression** and taking pride in our work
- **Literacy skills** like book care and recognizing familiar words
- **Math skills** like counting, sorting, comparing
- **Science skills** like constructing, experimenting and observing

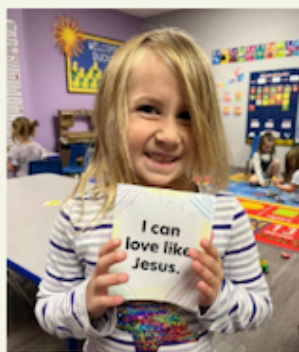

Before and after care is available at an additional charge and is invoiced separately. Before care opens at 7:00 a.m. Aftercare closes at 5:00 p.m.

Children must be 3 years of age before August 1st of the current school year and must be 100% toilet trained to enroll.

A **NON-REFUNDABLE** registration fee is due upon registration to ensure your child's spot.

The first tuition payment is due August 1st of the current school year and is not related to how many days are in the school year. The lump sum yearly tuition is broken down into 10 equal payments.
